Varied early Baroque program

'Musica Ficta', the excellent Colombian early music ensemble, has released a new CD with the American label Centaur, entitled 'Dos estrellas le siguen - 17th Century Xácaras and Dances in Spain and Latin America'. This is a varied, partly instrumental and partly vocal program. The songs and dances bestow a good notion of mostly early Baroque music in the Iberian peninsula as well as in the Spanish and Portuguese colonies. Above all, 'Musica

Ficta' fascinates with an inspired, highly colored and vigorous singing and playing. A particular bonus are the voices of Andres Silva and Antonio Santos, standing out with very clear and characterful vocals (Centaur CRC 3501).
